About the Role

HQ offers rapid, on-site laboratory testing for HIV and other sexually transmitted bloodborne infections (STBBIs) such as syphilis, gonorrhea, chlamydia, HIV, and HCV. These tests will be processed and diagnosed within hours, enabling same-day results. This capability allows HQ to provide immediate prevention and treatment services, such as PrEP, PEP, and HIV care.

We are currently seeking a qualified and motivated full-time Medical Laboratory Technologists to support the express testing services for HIV and STBBIs. These positions will work together to manage testing procedures using the Abbott Alinity I series and Hologic Panther systems.

Key Responsibilities

- Conduct analytical tests, assess results, and generate accurate reports.
- Prepare and issue detailed reports on laboratory samples and specimens.
- Maintain meticulous laboratory records and document test results.
- Operate and maintain laboratory equipment and instruments.
- Perform a variety of laboratory tests with high accuracy and precision.
- Identify and report any issues, failures, or concerns to the supervisor.
- Recognize abnormal and critical results, taking appropriate actions per standard operating procedures.
- Provide training and mentorship to junior technologists, students, and clinical fellows.
- Manage inventory, ensuring adequate reagents and supplies are always available.
- Contribute to the development, implementation, and improvement of quality management policies and procedures.
- Adhere to health and safety protocols in the laboratory.
- Prepare and ship samples to Public Health Ontario and other external laboratories as
- Perform quality control checks and document control results, addressing any quality issues as needed.
- Escalate unresolved quality control concerns to the supervisor.

- Demonstrated ability to maintain accurate records and documentation.
- Ability to collaborate effectively in a team environment.
- Strong leadership, problem-solving, decision-making, and critical thinking skills.
