This full-time Nurse position at HQ will support the delivery of clinical services, providing compassionate, patient-centered care to individuals in the 2SMSMGBTNB+ community. The Nurse will be responsible for conducting assessments, administering treatments, supporting health education, and coordinating care.

You will work closely with a team to ensure clients receive comprehensive, tailored services. including sexual health and mental health care. The role also involves contributing to care protocols and promoting health equity in a safe, welcoming environment. This is an opportunity to make a meaningful impact on the health and well-being of a diverse community.

Kev Responsibilities

- Provide clinical services to cis men, trans, and non-binary individuals in a culturally safe, inclusive, and non-judgmental environment.
- Collaborate with the HQ team to create, update, and deliver educational materials related to sexual health.
- Offer clinical advice, education, and counseling for the testing, diagnosis, and treatment of sexually transmitted and bloodborne infections (e.g., HIV, syphilis, gonorrhea, chlamydia), in line with established guidelines.
- Assist with contact tracing and partner notification when necessary.
- Perform advanced health assessments, including anoscopy, venipuncture, and physical exams, as part of client screenings.
- Foster positive working relationships with internal and external staff to ensure seamless service delivery for clients.
- Evaluate clinical and social support needs, making culturally sensitive referrals to enhance overall wellness.
- Maintain and update comprehensive electronic medical records.



Required Qualifications & Experience

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) preferred.
- Current registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario (CNO).
- Current registration with RNAO for professional insurance.
- Adhere to privacy and confidentiality standards under the Personal Health Information Protection Act (PHIPA) and CNO's Confidentiality and Privacy standards.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills, including listening and teaching abilities.
- Experience providing primary care and diagnostic services in a clinical setting.
