About the Role

The Sexual Health Peer Navigator ensures a welcoming and convenient experience for HQ's sexual health testing service users.

Volunteer shifts are flexible, with office hours from Monday to Thursday (12PM-7:30PM) and Fridays (12PM-5:30PM). Volunteers can choose from four 2-hour shifts per day, committing to at least one shift per week.

Training is provided, and volunteers work in a team to assist new users with registration at the front desk.

Responsibilities:

- Registering individuals at the kiosk
- Assisting in finding available self-testing rooms
- Identifying the correct sample kits

Required Skills:

- Good spoken and written English
- Availability during daytime and evening shifts
- Ability to communicate politely and respectfully
- Self-motivated and able to work independently

Additional Skills:

- Effective communication with diverse cultural groups
- Knowledge about the 2SLGBTQ+ community is a plus
- Fluency in an additional language is preferred but not required
